The folks at NBC's Dateline have ne doubt of that, however, after being subjected to Pearce's excruciating public dismemberment of the television magazine show's portrayal of GM's older pickup trucks as rolling safety hazards.

The courtroom-style performance Pearce conducted on the ground floor of GM's corporate headquarters a few weeks ago left no doubt about the nearly unbelievable aloppiness and lack of ethics on the part of the Dateline crew, who had allowed a consultant working for the plaintiff's side

in a product-liability case against GM to wire up the truck with re-mote-controlled rocket motors to ensure the gas tank would go off

on cue.

In fact, Dateline's position was so indefensible, it was no big achievement to discredit the show.

What was more remerkable was Pearce's controlled, but visibly

ongry, presentation — a methodi-cal examination of every detail of how and why the gas tank burst into Inames on camera.

Pearce's tour de force of techni-cal investigation was likely the first time any auto company exec-tive had managed an impas-sioned, credible, statement that went beyond defending its prod-ucts, and began to counter the

most damning impression left in the wake of most product liability suits — that the company involved is callous, aloppy, and uncarring about public safety.
