JUDGING IF THERAPY SUCCEEDS

If you are under treatment for arthritis, what can you expect that regimen to achieve? It is unlikely that medication will completely resolve your joint pain. Therefore you and your physician need to define success with lesser goals in mind.

From experience, doctors accept that therapy is appropriate if it accomplishes the following:

1. Permits you to work
2. Limits your morning stiffness
3. Changes your pattern of fatigue to an intermittent occurrence
4. Reduces joint swelling to a minimum.

None of these criteria are specific. For example, the degree of joint capacity required for work is far more if you are a construction than if you are employed in an office.

Doctors consider morning stiffness controlled if you can resolve it within a half hour of arising and fatigue overcome if you are able to work one week out of two.

Established, joint swelling to a minimal degree and of a tolerable extent is a judgement you make.

Success therapy is not determined by reaching goals. Rather you assess where you were when you started treatment, and judge if you are now where you can reasonably remain.
