The Department of Housing and Urban Development has advised the City of Farmington Hills that it is entitled to receive \$412,000.00 for the 1993-94 Community Development Block Grant Program Year. These funds have been authorized by the Department of Housing and Urban Development under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 and 1977, as amended. In addition, an estimated \$60,000.00 will be received in program income from the Housing Rehabilitation activities. Notice is hereby given that on Monday, March 15, 1993, at 7:30 p.m. Eastern Standard Time, in the Council Chamber of the City Hall, 31555 Eleven Mile Road, City of Farmington Hills, Oakland County, Michigan, at which time and place the Farmington Hills City Council will conduct a Public Hearing to discuss the proposed use of Community Development Block Grant funds.

The proposed statement of Community Development objectives and projected use of funds for the 1993-94 CDBG Program Year is as follows:

**PROPOSED STATEMENT
OF
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM 1993-94
City of Farmington Hills**

The City of Farmington Hills has considered the various eligible projects which may be undertaken with Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. These activities range from construction of sidewalks, storm/sanitary sewers, water lines and street paving to public services, code/enforcement, historic preservation, etc. After careful evaluation of these projects, it has been determined that the highest priority of needs for low and moderate income areas in the community would be achieved through the following expenditures of CDBG funds:

Capital improvement projects for possible consideration include:

1. Randall Drainage/Street Paving Improvements (Section 25) - Petition Submitted by Homeowners. Estimated Cost: \$104,500.00
2. Randall Storm Sewer (Section 35) Estimated Cost: \$180,000.00.
3. Ruth Avenue Drainage Improvement (Section 34) Estimated Cost: \$500,000.00.
4. Fenit Drainage Improvement (Section 33) Estimated Cost: \$130,000.00.
5. Edmondson Drainage Improvement (Section 34) Estimated Cost: \$114,000.00.
6. Cora/Haynes/Aster Drainage and Paving Improvement (Section 35) Estimated Cost: \$18,000.00.

Please note that only a portion of these projects could be completed due to the funding levels. It is felt, however, that an opportunity for public discussion should be given on these projects.
All projects proposed with the use of the 1993-94 CDBG funds, as noted above, will benefit low and moderate income areas or persons defined in the 1990 Census.
All CDBG activities have been designed to avoid the displacement of persons. In the event displacement becomes necessary, the City will assist displaced persons in accordance with the Federal Uniform Relocation Act.

1993-94 CDBG Program - the Final Statement of Community Development Objectives and Projected Use of Funds for 1993-94 Program Year included the above distribution of funds. It is anticipated that on June 30, 1993, the end of the Program Year, the status of the expenditures will be as follows:

HOUSING REHABILITATION:	71% EXPENDED OR COMMITTED (Approximately \$18,000.00 will be carried over for future rehabilitation activities.)
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS:	Ballast Drainage Improvement completed with 100% expended (\$78,000.00) 100% expended (\$25,500.00)
CODE ENFORCEMENT:	100% expended (\$25,500.00)
ADMINISTRATION:	100% expended (\$24,500.00)

Also, no persons will be displaced by the above activities.

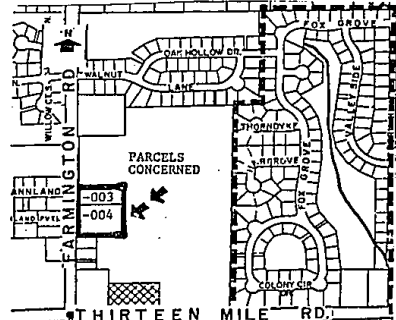

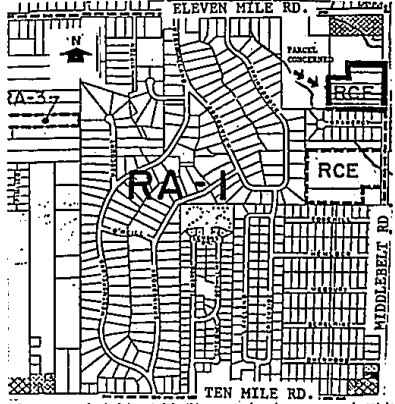
