

## POLICE/FIRE CALLS

**■ Listed below are some of the Farmington-area police incidents, fire calls and court cases reported during the past week.**

■ **FIRE**

A smoke alarm was set off at the Farmington Co-op village clubhouse on Nine Mile Feb. 27 during a party when a Tupperware bowl was left on a burner. Firefighters from Station No. 1 in Farmington Hills responded, but there was no fire and no damage to the stove.

A serviceman from MetroVision reported smoke coming from the rear of a residence on York Ridge in Farmington Hills on Feb. 26. Firefighters from Station No. 4 responded and put out the fire that had started in a rear bedroom, with ignited bedding causing the fire.

Firefighters from Station No. 2 in Farmington Hills put out a fire caused by a short circuit at a house on Skye Drive on Feb. 28. The fire started behind the wall of the family room.

■ **THEFTS**

Recording equipment worth more than \$60,000 was taken from

the Albert Street Recording Studio on Orchard Lake in Farmington Hills Feb. 26. The business owner did not authorize the removal of an Otari MX80 24-track recording machine worth \$32,000, a Lexicon digital sound effects processor worth \$30,000 and other equipment.

Tools and a tool box valued at \$450 were stolen from the garage of a residence on Tredwell on Feb. 27.

■ **ETHNIC INTIMIDATION**

A swastika, ethnic slurs and the words "We will kill you" were written in the snow in the yard of a residence on Pine View in Farmington Hills between Feb. 26-27.

■ **AUTO THEFT**

A 1992 blue Mercury Cougar valued at \$18,000 was stolen from a location on Northwestern Highway in Farmington Hills Feb. 26. The suspect is described as a tall black male, in his 20s wearing a red jacket.

A cellular phone valued at \$197 was stolen from a 1992 Ford Explorer parked on Northwestern Highway in Farmington Hills Feb. 27.

■ **BREAK-INS**

An attempted break-in at a residence on Branchester in Farmington Hills Feb. 25 caused \$200 in damage to the front doors.

■ **VANDALISM**

A driver's side window on a blue 1988 Suzuki Samurai parked at the 7-11 store on Orchard Lake in Farmington Hills Feb. 27 was broken, causing \$200 in damage.

Two front windows of a residence on Springbrook in Farmington Hills were shot out with a BB gun between Feb. 25 or 26, causing \$250 in damage.

A room at the Knight's Inn on Grand River in Farmington Hills was damaged between Feb. 27-28. Empty wine bottles and beer cans were found in the room after a man checked out. Damage to towel bars, a glass mirror and other fixtures amounted to \$500.

Vandals scratched a 1990 Nissan 300ZX over the entire body, causing \$1,000 in damage, and took the center pieces from the wheels, which were valued at \$75. The incident took place at the Gateway Apartments on Gateway Drive in Farmington Hills March 1.

## Suspect faces trial in local carjacking case

A Detroit man accused of a carjacking at a car dealership in Farmington Hills was bound over to circuit court and will be arraigned there on March 9.

Duron Henton, 19, was bound over on Feb. 22 in 47th District Court on charges of kidnapping a car salesman from Bill Cook Bu-

ick and stealing a 1993 Nissan 300ZX on Oct. 9, 1992. He had pleaded not guilty to the charges.

Henton is accused of asking Daniel Wagner, a Nissan salesman, to take him for a test drive, then kidnapping him at gunpoint. Another Detroit, Earl Bruce Williams, had been charged with

the crime. But the case was dismissed when Wagner said at a Nov. 13, 1992, pretrial exam that Williams was the carjacker. Henton was identified at his pretrial exam on Feb. 22 and ordered to post a cash surety bond of \$10,000. He remains in the Oakland County Jail.

## Man charged in robbery

A Redford man is accused of robbing a restaurant, leaving police to flush out the evidence that led to his arrest.

Thomas Timothy Tripp, 23, was arraigned before Magistrate James Brady in 47th District Court in Farmington Tuesday, charged with unarmed robbery, a five-year felony, for a holdup of the White Castle restaurant Sunday at 10:40 p.m. He pleaded not guilty.

A clerk at the restaurant told police a man told her he was armed and dangerous and demanded money. When police arrived, the clerk told them the man had come out of the men's room.

Police found the remnants of a food stamp booklet with an identifying name and number.

The man owning the book, matched the description of the holdup man.
