OU landscape architect Albert Norhodon said students who are members of People for the Ethical Treatment of Animals threatened to picket the pigeons killers, then another group called Putting Peo-ple First and it would picket the picketers.

"We're not killing pigeons," Norhoden said. "I've had enough pigeon publicity. I'm pigeoned

out."

Instead, the powers that be have concluded that fencing the pigeons out of their home is the best solution. In the spring, Norheden said, a fence will be attached to the girders that support the refrigerated room, barring the flock from its abode.




