Sourat (1859-1891) developed a technique called pointillism. His paintings consist of dots of color that blend to create the effect of shimmering light and subtle color variations at a distance. His painting used for the poster, a scene of people relaxing on a sunny day, took the artist two years to complete.

Completing the poster design involved electronic imaging and conventional hand illustration. The original painting is in the Art Institute of Chicago. After obtaining the right to use a photo of the work for reproduction, Zapico and the team made a transparency on the computer.

They imitated Sourat's style in drawing the race cars and the Detroit skyline. Computer scanning helped them with the coloring and design. Computers also enabled them to reposition boats from the original drawing and extend the artist's frame around the entire scene.

Sourat's painting was set along the Seine River. La Grand Jatte was an island in the Seine near Paris. Among the alterations made for the poster were putting in a road to replace the river bank, removing a fishing rod from a woman's hand and placing her hand on her hip, and extending a man's leg.

"All the parallels were there," Zapico said.

The Grand Prix poster is selling for \$15 at poster shops and galleries throughout metropolitan Detroit. 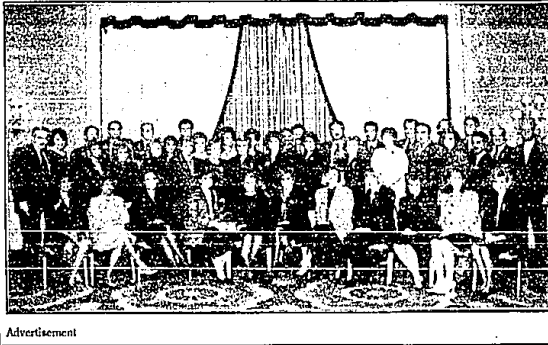
