stitutional rights wherever we see them infringed. (Patterson) may see us in court on this issue."
The other co-organizer, University of Michigan student Adam Brook, noted that the Show Mobile was rented fair and square. "Oakland County was paid for the rental of its stage," he said. "They offered it for rent. That's (Patterson's) problem. Fie certainly hasn't called me, and I challenge him to a so." the other county officials, they're all on Patterson's side.


