In the second game, Joe Jentzer (2-1) blanked Concordia on six hits, winning 4-0.

"I just can't say enough about our pitching," George said. "Our team earned run average (2.89) is lower than our batting average (.295) and that is real rare. I have five guys that I can call my No. 1 starter."

Hayward and Grabetz are 3-0, McKnight is 3-1, Jeff Gugelman is 2-1 and Coleman is 1-3.

"When we lost our ace reliever (Sean Henkel), that put a lot of extra pressure on the starters and they've really come through for us," George said.

Henkel, a junior who stretched some muscles in his throwing shoulder, is lost for the season. George said he will petition the NAIA for a medical waiver so that Henkel doesn't lose a year of eligibility.

"It's nice to be where we are at this point in the season," George said. "But I really don't think we've played as well as we are going to. Our defense has got to get better and we still have a couple career .300 hitters who aren't hitting .300."

He does have eight .300 hitters, however, led by Hayward (.340, four homers), Brusseu (.337) and Miller (.326). Craig Overaitis (.319) is tied with Solak and Hayward for the team lead in homers with four, and leads with 19 RBI.
