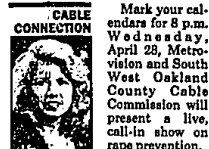


Cable presents call-in show on rape prevention

Mark your calendars for 8 p.m. Wednesday, April 28, Metrovision and South West Oakland County Cable Commission will present a live, call-in show on rape prevention.

The program entitled "Without Consent" is co-produced by John Cooper, the Channel 7, 11 p.m. news director and Mary Calderone, community outreach coordinator at commission.

The National Coalition Against Sexual Assault has designated April as Sexual Assault Awareness month. Statistics prove that as the warm weather arrives, the incidence of rape does escalate. The producers emphasize that the program will offer sound, non-sensational advice on how women can protect themselves in the event that they are attacked.

Re-enactment of actual events and heart rendering accounts of real situations will offer the tele-

vision viewer much food for thought.

The program is live. Be sure to call 473-7256 between 8 and 9 p.m. on April 28.

Ann Thompson, Channel 4 news reporter, will moderate the show. Jeff and Connie Duncan will demonstrate the art of self-defense. Choi Kwang Do. Simple moves to fend off would-be attackers will be shown.

The Haven, Oakland County's domestic Violence and Sexual Assault Emergency Shelter and Counseling Center, will be represented by Joyce Wright. She will describe how to deal with the emotional and psychological aspects of assault. Because the subject matter is of such great matter, MetroVision will provide simultaneous viewership throughout its cable franchises on Channel 12.
