Suspect, 25, awaits court date in shooting incident

A 25-year-old man faces arraignment in Detroit Recorder's Court on charges stemming from a shooting incident April 16 when a Farmington Hills resident was fired upon outside a friend's Redford Township house.

Michael Lee Wolsey waived a preliminary examination Tuesday in Redford's 17th District Court and was bound over for arraignment by Judge Richard Manning.

Wolsey is to be arraigned May 11 in recorder's court on charges of assault with a dangerous weapon and possession of a firearm during commission of a felony.
He previously stood mute to the

charges April 16 at arraignment before Redford's district court Judge Karen Khalil, who entered not guilty pleas for him. Wolsey was released from custody after he posted \$1,000 cash bond following arraignment.

He faces up to four years in prison if convicted of the assault charge, plus a mandatory, two-year prison term upon conviction of the firearm charge.

Neither of the two men was hit by the gunfire and no one was injured, but several bullets hit their car, Redford police said. The incident followed a traffic altercation.

AIDS conference for teens stresses substance abuse risk

Sixty high school students learned why substance abuse can influence the transmission of the AIDS virus during a day-long conference.

The Midwest AIDS Prevention Project, the Hemophilia Foundation of Michigan and the Troy Community Coalition for the Prevention of Drug and Alcohol Abuse presented the program entitled DATA (Drugs, Alcohol, Teenagers and AIDS) on April 28 at the Troy Community Center, 520 W. Big Beaver.

"It was a first-time effort. We plan to have the conference next year at Macomb Community College," said Steven Wood, program director for MAPP.

Speakers included representatives from Planned Parenthood, the American Red Cross and the Oakland and Macomb county health departments.

Most attendees were hand-picked by teachers or counselors because they're leaders in their respective school and can pass along the information learned at

the conference to their peers," Wood said.
Starting the conference off was a Crecroads Production play, "My Name is Pam Rogers and I Have AIDS."
