The bride is a graduate of Western Michigan University.

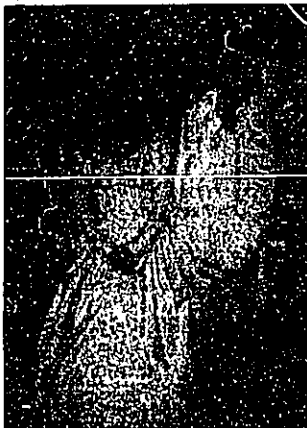
The groom is student at St. Clair Community College and is employed as a chef at Denny's Restaurant in Port Huron.
