Group protests outcome-based education approach

Angry and upset over a program which they feel has endangered their child, about 50 parents and educators gathered Wednesday night to protest the outcome-based education policy of Oakland Schools.

The meeting held at Southfield-Lathrup High School, focused on such outcome-based educational practices as the abolition of the conventional grading system and an emphasis on qualitative learning, values and group work.

Public act targeted: A major target for the speakers was Public Act 201 of 1992, set by the state Legislature which made outcome-based education part of a new core curriculum for Michigan's public schools.
