with the new people. To teach tennis, the camp has a regular tennis professional. Water skiing, horseback riding and scuba also have professional instructors. "The camp has a real good arts and crafts director and sports people, but I guarantee the other ones," he says, referring to his four "pros."

Cohn himself can teach fencing, scuba diving or swimming but he usually leaves that to the staff. "I try to get involved in the activities

with the kids."

This is Maplehurst Camp's 38th year. "My father started it, and I was a camper there," Cohn recalls. Both he and his father also are psychologists who teach at the University of Michigan-Dearborn.

Cohn holds a doctorate in psychology from U-M. On the Dearborn campus, he conducts psychology classes concerning parent-child relationships and adolescence and socialization of

the child.

At camp, he teaches a college course for counselors-in-training. The course is offered through U-M, and students can get course credit while working with the children. Comparing Maplehurst to other camps, he says, "Not too many have professors who are running the camp."

Cohn's wife Brenda supervises the camp office. His parents have a home on the camp grounds and stay there for the whole camp pe-

riod.

Although Cohn and his father are psychologists, the camp isn't intended for problem children. "We deal with normal children. Inevitably, children who have problems, we deal with that," he says. When parents are interested in signing their kids up for camp, he may explain that no therapy is offered. "We want to pay attention to kids who are being good and following the rules."
