Q. I had to admit my wife into a nursing home. They asked all types of questions about my finances. I did not want to tell them how much I have or the amount of assets in my estate. The nursing home said they would not take her unless I answered their ques-tions. Do they have a right to do this?

A. As I understand, private-pay-only facilities may insist on financial information as a condi-tion of admission. Nursing homes that accept Medicare of Medicaid cannot ask for financial state-ments. They may, however, in-quire as to the source of payment (such as Medicare, Medicaid or private insurance).
