POLICE/FIRE CALLS

Listed below are some of the Farmington area police incidents, fire calls and court cases reported during the past week.

THEFT
A purse containing \$220 in cash was stolen from a restricted area of Botsford Hospital on Grand River in Farmington Hills June 17.

BREAK-IN

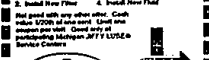

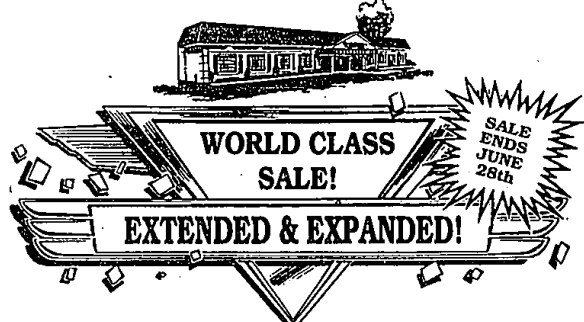
