GALLSTONE DISEASE

Approximately 10 to 15% of the adult population or more than 20 million people in the United States have Gallstones. It is estimated that there are about one million newly diagnosed patients annually. The prevalence is higher in women, twice as high compared to men. The prevalence is also higher with multiple pregnancy, obesity and rapid weight loss, as well as older patients and in certain ethnic groups. Most patients with Gallstones remain asymptomatic for many years and may in fact never develop symptoms. However, the consequences of Gallstones may be severe. Pregnancy is a significant risk factor and some smaller stones could dissolve spontaneously sometime after delivery. Pregnancy associated with obesity adds even higher risk and the Gallstones tend to remain after delivery, most likely the patient begins to notice symptoms especially if it is larger than 1 cm.
