



At (7) she ruffed another diamond with dummy's heart 10. At (8) a spade ruffed with her trump seven. Now the king, jack of hearts, and here was the handsome three-card



Alan Truscott would have gloried in our fair lady's play if at trick (11) Beverly had thrown East on lead with her last trump end playing the defense in spades. She was almost sure that spectacular play would work, but the consequences would have been humiliating if East's last three cards had been a club, spade and high trump. It wasn't her style to enact such a melodrama. That she would leave to the Zias. She therefore played a diamond, which East could ruff anytime, but that was it for the defense.
