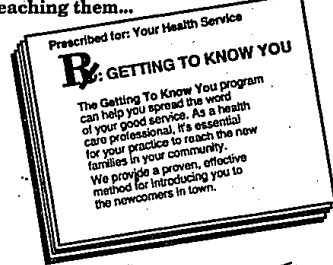
Auction prize

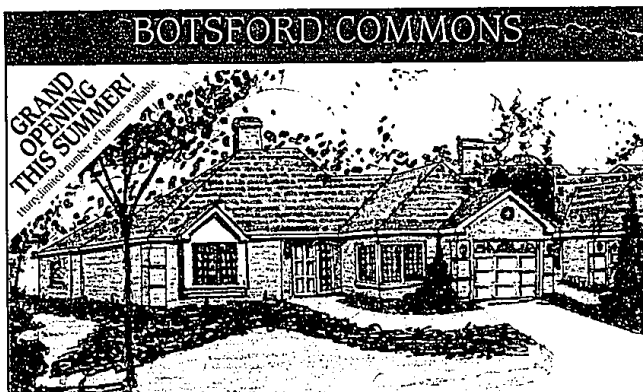
