Beloved 'Loving' actor dies

Bernard Barrow, who played Louie Slavinsky on ABC's "Loving," died of lung cancer on Wednesday, Aug. 4, in New York City's Lenox Hill hospital.

Executive producer Haidee Granger says, "Bernie's death has come as a shock to his friends and colleagues at 'Loving.' Bernie brought a zest and joie de vivre to his role and to our studio. Because of his kindness and support, he made the task of creating a daily show a true pleasure. Bernie was much loved and respected and will be greatly missed."

The actor was well-loved by fans, who enjoyed his charming, affable portrayals. Barrow's characters were famous for doling out good advice and always helping those in need — much like the actor himself.

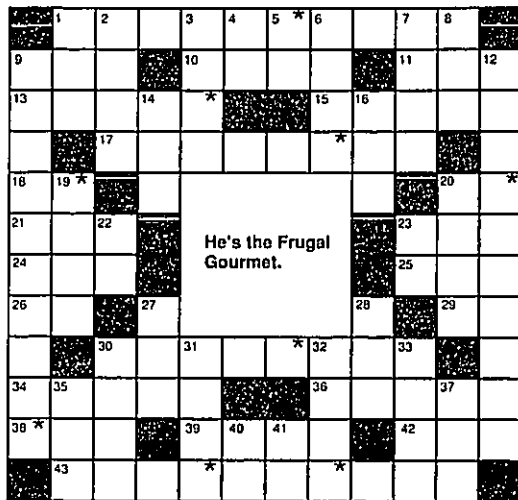
Barrow received the Emmy Award as Best Supporting Actor for his portrayal of Louie in 1991. He was nominated for two additional Emmys in the leading actor category for his work as Johnny Ryan on ABC's multiaward-winning daytime drama "Ryan's Hope." His other television credits include "The Edge of Night," "The Secret Storm," "Law & Order" and "The Waltons."

The veteran performer, born Dec. 30, 1927, began his professional career as a child radio actor in the 1940s. He graduated to the theater, appearing in musical and dramatic regional productions, and then went on to perform in motion pictures. His films include "Serpico," "Rachel, Rachel," "Glass Houses," "Claudine" and "The Survivors."

Barrow earned his doctorate in theater history from Yale University and was on the faculty of Brooklyn College from 1955 until his retirement from academia in 1983 as Professor Emeritus. Many of his students, including Jimmy Smits, have gone on to distinguished careers.

A native New Yorker, Barrow was raised in Manhattan's Yorkville section. He is survived by his wife, actress Joan Kaye of Manhattan; his children, Susan Barrow and Thomas E.L. Barrow; and stepchildren, Dr. Richard Katz and Sue Ann Cates.
