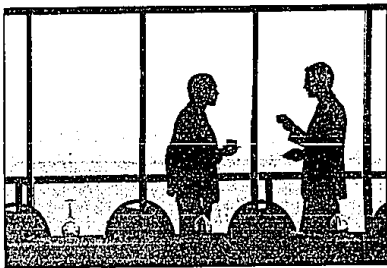

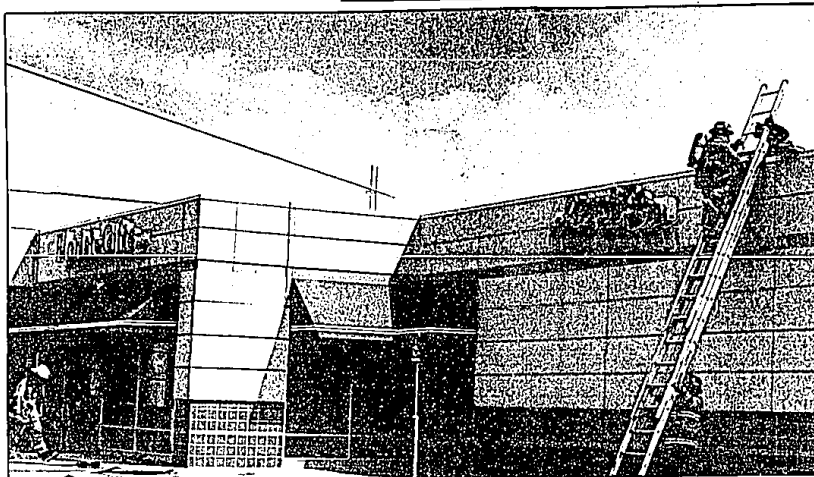

## Group makes history with 3 new publications

A new book and two new booklets on area history were announced by the Farmington Hills Historical Commission.

Kathryn Briggs, who chairs the organization, said more than 15 publications are now available from the commission, one of the most extensive book programs by any historical group in the state.

A new, revised edition of "Heritage Homes of Farmington" by Ruth Moehman describes and includes pictures of significant area historical homes. The 245-page hardcover costs \$14.95.

Farmington's role in the underground railroad is recorded in a new booklet, "Tracking the Underground Railroad" by Jean M. Fox. It will be released soon. More than 21 illustrations are included in the 40-page booklet at \$4.95.

A new booklet, "The Old Mill" by Frank Steele, describing the landmark formerly in Sleepy Hollow, is \$2.

The Farmington Hills Historical Commission oversees historical displays, markers, videos, publications, and other local history projects.

A variety of interests are covered in the selection of books. A fascinating history of Michigan politics 100 years ago is chronicled in "Fred M. Warner, Progressive Governor," by Fox. Warner was Michigan governor

from 1905-11, and his restored home is now a turn-of-the-century museum and meeting place in Farmington. With 129 illustrations, the 493-page hardcover book is \$24.95.

History of the noted area inn and restaurant, restored by Henry Ford, is described in the "160 Years of Botsford Inn" by Fox. The 187-page hard-cover book is \$19.95.

A memorable look at a talented artist and her life is found in "A Farmington Childhood — The Watercolors of Lillian Drake Avery" by Fox with John B. Cameron.

Reproductions of 10 of the artist watercolors of early Oakland County scenes are included in the 70-page 11 by 14 inch book at \$14.95 for soft and \$29.95 for

hardcover. Ten color reproductions for framing are \$10.

Other softcover books include "The Natural History of Farmington," 68 pages, \$3.95; "Farmington's Centennial Families" by Stella Strye, 44 pages, \$3.95; "Historic District Homes," published by the Farmington Hills Historic District Commission, with 189 pages is \$10.

Booklets, called monographs, at \$2 each, include "P. Dean Warner of Farmington" (city's first mayor in 1887 and state public servant), "Marcus Burrows, English Revival Architect" (of Farmington) by Fox; "History of the Farmington Post Office" by Erika Peckham, and "Communism Comes to Farmington: The Workers Camp" by James Dermody.

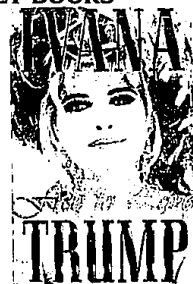
