Proposal would put 6 houses in undeveloped area

Developer Carol Peoples is seeking city permission to build a cluster of six single-family housing units on a 24-acre wooded site on the northwest corner of Edgemont and 10 Mile in the western edge of Southfield, near the Farmington Hills border.

"I'm seeking the cluster option (attached single family houses) because I want to save as many trees and preserve as much of the nature of the area as possible," Peoples soid. "But I've made up my mind that if they (the city)

don't want it that way I can do it the other way."

A public hearing on Peoples' request was scheduled for last night's planning commission meeting, but city planner Barbara McBeth said it would be tabled at McBeth said it would be tabled at the request of the applicant be-cause her tree survey of the prop-erty had not yet been completed. The planning department's pre-hearing recommendation will be delayed, McBeth said. "We're

waiting to see what the tree survey turns up."
Despite the proximity to streams, there are no wetlands on the property that would hinder the development, McBeth added.
Peoples, a resident of South-field for more than 15 years, has developed residential and commercial property in Michigan.
The houses in her proposed development would be up to 2,000 square feet in size, she said.

While "fill-in" single family homes have continued to be built in Southfield neighborhoods, few residential developments have gone up in the city in recent years. The largest development is Susace Woods, a 60-lot project that's been under construction since the leaf 188%

Also, McBeth said a seven-house development is under way at Fairfield and 11 Mile.
