
External View of Head and N Showing Position of Veins.

In spite of this system, however, if care of the product at the source of production is lacking, deterioration will occur before the product reaches the consumer.

If positry is to reach the consumer with the best of flavor and wholesomenies, the most attractive appearance, it must be properly raised; tilled, and freesed. Granting that the chicken has been bred and fed to be a good eating chicken and that it is ready for slaughter, the first step in the preservation of the good qualities is to starve it for twenty-four hours, allowing, however, a theref, supply, of fresh, clean water during this period.


