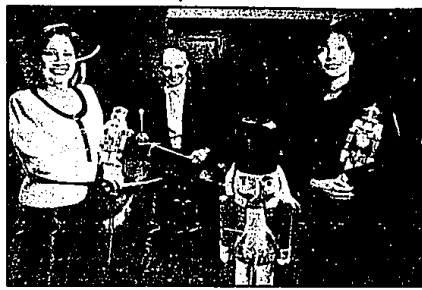


Tough duty: Bloomfield Hills policemen Jon Gray and Howard Smith give idea to Giftorama treasurer Jigger Jigger Smith.
