

# Falcons cruise past Stevenson

The Farmington High boys cross country team won its fourth dual meet without a loss Thursday, 23-33, against Livonia Stevenson at Oakland Community College.

The Falcons are 3-0 in the Western Lakes Activities Association Lakes Division.

The Falcons were led by Jason Jackson and Kevin Afterbaugh, who placed first and second, respectively. Jackson finished the 5,000 meters in 17 minutes, 40 seconds and Afterbaugh crossed the finish line in 17:48.

"With it being so hot it was tough to run," Farmington coach Chip Bridges said. "We just ran to win and did a nice job."

Farmington's Tom May placed fifth (18:00), Mike Langdon was seventh (18:15) and Mark Kurzer eighth (18:29). Trip Adams placed 10th (19:11).

The Spartans, who ran without their top runner Scott Creehan, who was injured, got a third-place finish from Jason Hayward (17:51) and a fourth place showing by Steve Warner (17:55).

Brian Hayward was sixth (18:04), Andrew Beach took ninth (19:00) and Tony D'Aristotle came in 11th (19:11).
