Encouraging the Buddy project, she pointed out, "I view it as a support group. Women are kind of alone in this battle."

A third way the center is taking part in National Breast Cancer Awareness Month is by using a floshing sign rented for the month at the Phoenix Center in Pontiac. The message conveyed is "to remind women to get a mammogram."




