HALLOWEEN HAUNTED WALK

SWIM LESSONS

OPEN SWIM
The Recreation Division has scheduled open swim at the Mercy Center pool for your enjoyment during the fall months. You may attend any of the following sessions:

- Monday-Friday, 6:30-8 a.m. and noon-1 p.m.
- Monday-Thursday, 4:30-5:30 p.m. and 8:30-9:30 p.m.
- Friday, 5:30-6:30 p.m. and 6:30-8 p.m.
- Saturday, 7:30-9 a.m. and 12:30-1:30 p.m.
- Sunday, 2:30-3:30 p.m. and 3:30-5 p.m.

Fees are \$2 per person for one hour, \$2.50 per person for one and one-half hours. You may purchase swim passes, valid for 60 days, one hour — \$18 for 10 swims, one and one-half hours — \$22.50 for 10 swims. Seniors 55 and handicapped, one hour \$16 for 10 swims, one and one-half hours \$18 for 10 swims.
