

# Area reps split on airline child safety seats

Here's how Observer & Eccentric-area members of Congress were recorded on a major roll call vote in the week ending Oct.

## HOUSE

**Child Safety Seats:** By a vote of 270 for and 155 against, the House gutted an amendment requiring airlines to provide safety seats for children under two years of age. The amendment would have resulted in parents having to buy a ticket for the infant. Under present policy, infants travel for free if they are held, and a ticket

## ROLL CALL REPORT

**Washington National Airport:** By a vote of 110 for and 294 against, the House refused to exempt Washington National Airport from a study of whether to permit more takeoffs and landings at four high-density airports. The vote occurred during debate on HR 2739 (above). It kept on track a proposed Transportation Department study of whether to allow increased traffic at National, O'Hare in Chicago and Kennedy and LaGuardia in New York.
