Porcelain art demonstrated

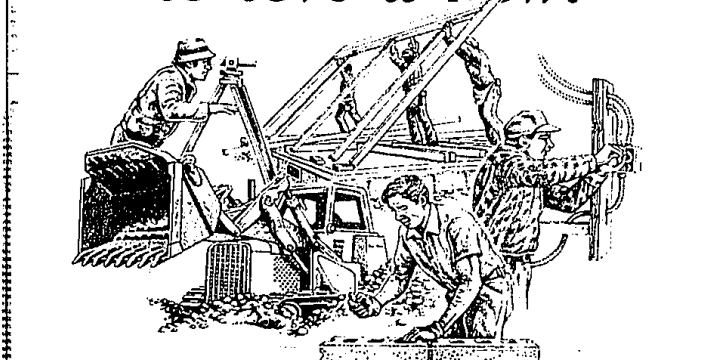
