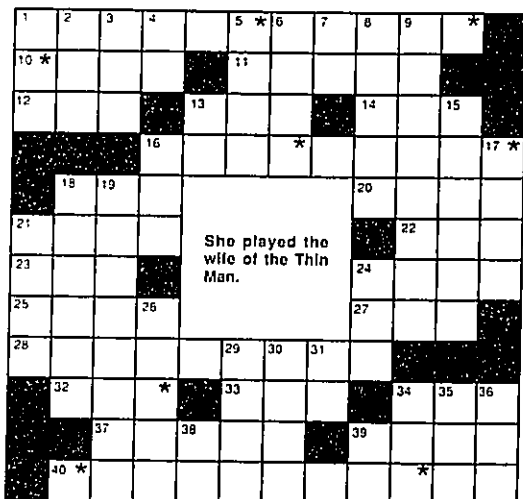


TV CROSSWORD

Lisa Rinna gets what she wants from life

Lisa Rinna, who portrays sexy Billie Reed on "Days of Our Lives," works hard and plays hard. She is a determined young woman whose motto is: "If you want it then go get it, and believe in yourself."

"I really do believe that," Rinna says. "We can make our destiny, and we do not have to sit around being miserable thinking about what we do not have. You have to live life."

Rinna says the Reginald Denny trial in Los Angeles helped her learn something about herself. "This is a guy who really forgave the people who hurt him. I cannot tell you what it was like for me when I watched him walk up and hug the mothers of the men who beat him and practically killed him. He wasn't bitter or seeking revenge. It was amazing."

Rinna is part of the dynamic soap opera supercouple, Bo and Billie, and that means long hours before the camera. But the actress says she doesn't let the pace of daytime get her down.

"It helps that I really like the people I work with," Rinna says. "I've seen other actresses let the work really get to them. To portray some of these parts convincingly you really have to rip yourself open, and it takes a lot out of you. If I have to I'll ask for a few days off when I think I need it."

Rinna makes the most of her time away from the "Days" studio. "I spend time with my boyfriend (Harry Hamlin)," the actress says, but she is hesitant to say much about the relationship. "Everybody knows about it, but you like try to keep some things private."

Rinna grew up in Oregon where she learned to love the outdoors. "I really enjoy working out. I love to go for long runs. My body needs it sometimes to relieve the stress. I also enjoy going to flea markets and hunting for antiques. But one of my favorite things to do is make chocolate chip cookies," Rinna says.

The actress has a loyal fan following and says she thinks her fans would be surprised if they saw the real Lisa Rinna. "When I'm not working I hang out in jeans and a T-shirt, and I don't wear makeup. I don't like all that stuff. Pretty much what you see is what you get."
