

Yule help Heritage Park raise funds at annual tour

Decorated trees and holiday displays will be featured. Other organizations in the community participate by decorating trees and having boutique tables. Santa will be talking to children during weekend hours.

The tour will be from noon to 5 p.m. Thursday and Friday; and from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday and Sunday. Lunch in the tea room also will be available.

The cost is \$3 for adults; \$2 for senior citizens and teenagers; \$1 for children 6-12. Children under 6 are free.

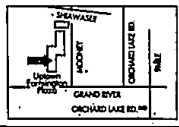
