After leaving the school he became a founding member of John Houseman's The Acting Company, where he performed in more than 20 plays in the repertory, on Broadway and on national tours. His feature film credits include "Manhunter" and "Russkies." He was also in several television movies.

Hendrickson, who created the role of Hal in December 1985, has also appeared in other daytime soap operas. He was Silas Crocker on "Guiding Light" and Chris Shaw on "Texas" and "Another World." ("Texas" was a spin-off from "AW.")

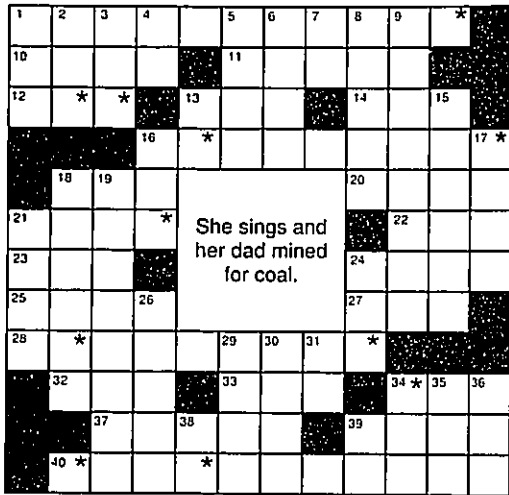
Dear Candace: I read both of your columns about "Loving," and I wanted to write and tell you how I feel about this show.
