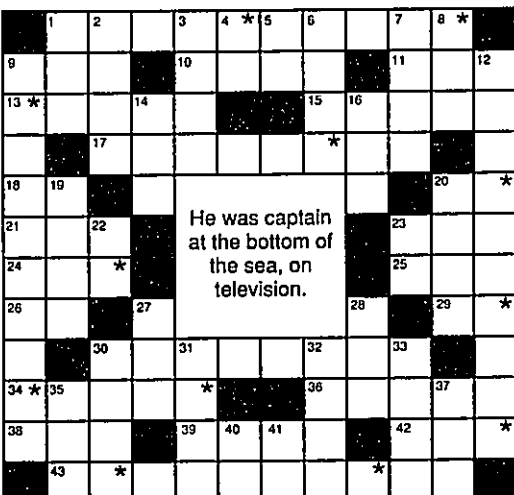


TV CROSSWORD

Carly (Crystal Chappell) was trying desperately to get Nicky (Erik Von Detten) out of the country and was shocked when Lawrence (Michael Sabatino) showed up to help her. (Carly, Lawrence and Nikki ended up leaving Salem for good.)
