Kroger expects to make a decision in the next two months, said Pruter. But in the meantime, the store has not renewed the lease of several stores that have either already moved or will move June 30, when their lease expires.

"Many of the stores had left because they, weren't doing well," Pruter said. "We've been working with the others to move them elsewhere in the mail or to another location." But that doesn't do Johnston But that doesn't do Johnston

He thought that his lease would be renewed and sold his borborshop, the Men's Quarters, to a couple contingent on the new lease. Now he and they are stuck, "I went shead end sold," he said. "Then I found out (Jan. 10) that the lease would not be extended."
Like it or not, meat of the stores have accepted their fate.

"They've pretty much thrown in the towel," Johnston said.

"I have no choice," said Sam Jaghab, owner of Ardmore Shoe Repair, who was in the process of noving to a location on Grand River and Nine Mile. "I don't know how it will go there. It's a shot in the dark." Bill Seekl, owner of Eyes Right, said he has some new locations in

mind and will decide where to

Prueter said that when that plan proved too costly and several of the tennals had already left the mall, the idea of expanding within it became a possibility. But if it were to expand inside the mall, it could not renew the existing leases.


"At this point I don't know (about expanding within the mall)," Pructer said. "Nothing has been decided."
