A pair of first timers were the big winners in Sunday's 18th annual West Bloomfield Half Marathon.

Northville's Jeff Martin and Romeo's Nancy Costello were the overall men's and women's champions in their West Bloomfield Half Marathon debuts.

The annual half-marathon race, organized by the West Bloomfield Parks and Recreation Department, included a field of 714 registered runners.

Hard-hitting Tucker tops Arias in final
