

North hits .500 with mercy win

Malone Chancy pitched a two-hitter and Kate Mackie smashed a two-run homer Friday in North Farmington's 10-5 softball victory over visiting Farmington.

The game was stopped after six innings because of the mercy rule.

The Raiders, 2-1 in the Lakes Division and 5-5 overall, have won their last four games.

Chancy struck out nine over 6 1/2 innings and walked seven. Becky Thurman fanned the only better she faced to record a hit.

North senior Allison Stein had two hits and two walks, stole three bases, scored two runs and had one RBI.

Renee Ouellette had three RBIs without benefit of a hit. She brought in one run with a sacrifice bunt, bases-loaded walk and groundout.

Chancy helped her cause with a hit and a run, and Mackie also had two walks and scored twice. Any Kizman had a hit and three walks, one RBI and a run. Lynette Zelasko accounted for the last of six North hits.

Farmington's Diane Ann had two-out, two-run double, and Jenny Sever had a bases-loaded walk.

The Falcons scored all three runs in the second inning to tie 3-3 until North went ahead with a single run in the bottom half.

Alana Heikkinen was the losing pitcher and combined with Sever to issue 16 walks.

On Wednesday, the Raiders thumped defending Western Lakes Activities Association champ Plymouth Canton 11-5. Chancy pitched seven innings for the

win. North had an 8-7 edge in hits and made two errors as opposed to Canton's four.

Ouellette had two hits and two RBIs. Mackie hit a two-run double and Stein had two hits, stole two bases and scored one run.

Renee Dolak added a hit and two RBIs, and Chancy and Kizman had one hit and one RBI apiece. Chancy also scored a play-off run.

"We played well offensively," North coach Dave Brubaker said. "Defensively, we had a couple mental errors, but we're starting to minimize those. And when you do, the physical errors are reduced."

"We're starting to do the fundamental things the proper way, and that ends up as wins in the long run."

CHURCHILL & HARRISON 3: The Hawks were competitive against one of the WLA's top teams Friday, but five errors led to five unanswered runs for the visiting Raiders.

Harrison led 2-0 after an inning and 3-2 after three.

Kozlarski allowed five hits and six walks but was hurt more by four errors — three in the fifth inning when Salem scored seven times to take a 9-5 lead.

LaCasse pitched 2 1/2 innings of hitless relief.

Harrison scored six runs in the fifth and sixth innings to regain the lead.
