# Star Theatres to start popping with canola oil

In response to customer con-cirns over the fat content of mov-le theater popcorn, Star Theatres will start using canola oil to pop popcorn.

The announcement was made by Barrie and Jim Loeks, chair-men of Star Theatres which oper-size 74 screens in eight locations in Michigan.

"Our goal is to provide our pa-trons with a healthier choice at our concession stands," said Bar-rie Loeks. "The change to canols

oil is in keeping with our custom-er service policy of making the movie-going experience enjoyable for every patron of Star Thea-tres."

Based on the recently released Center for Science in the Public Interest food test, the saturated fat content of popcorn popped in canola oil is only 7 percent compared to 86 percent for compopped in coconut oil. The change to cenola oil will be in effect by Friday, May 13.
