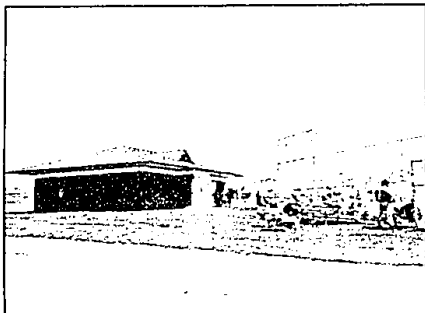

The four ball fields, three soccer fields, comfort station, two basketball courts, four sand volleyball courts, bocce ball court, trails, picnic areas and parking were all part of the first phase of a plan to buy and develop the park. The land, formerly a sod farm for Glen Eden Lutheran Cemetery, was bought with Michigan Trust Fund Grant money (\$2 million) and city parks and recreation tax money (\$1.89 million).

"I love it," said Hills resident Lynn Stuart as she watched her son play baseball. "This is really a nice facility."

Farmington Soccer Club president Tim Zajaros was fairly basking in the sun at the site of the new fields. The Farmington resident said the additional fields will not only provide enough practice and game fields, but will allow the city to rotate fields, keeping some out of service so they can be in top-shape.

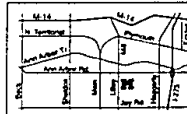
