The carillon an instrument consisting of 23 cast bronze bells and a mechanical playing board. The Wallace Carillon of Christ Church Cranbrook, installed in 1922, is comprised of 50 cast bronze bells. Carillonneurs use both their hands and feet when playing, sending clappers into the stationary bells by striking baton-like keys.

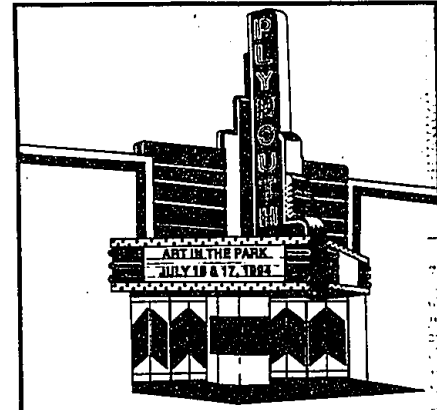
