Falcons impress at Hawks tourney

There is no better coaching tool than victory. Farmington volleyball coach Julie Ingalls has preached the benefits of team play over and over to her team and at the season-opening Farmington Harrison Invitational Saturday, the Falcons saw first-hand that she was right.

The Falcons went 3-2-1 in the eight-team tournament, losing to champion West Bloomfield in the finals, 15-10, 15-3. They beat Troy in the semifinals, 15-11, 15-10.

"The girls have really been focused on being a team and playing as a team and that's what we got Saturday," said Ingalls. "A lot of people contributed and we showed great hustle and attitude. The kids were very pleased."

West Bloomfield, the only team to beat Farmington on the day, won its third Harrison title in four years. The Lakers beat Bloomfield Hills Lahser in the other semifinal match, 15-12, 15-12.

"They really dominated their pool and were clearly the best team here," said Harrison coach Ron Shortt. "This was a nice tournament and nice way to start the season. Outside of West

Farmington's top gun was senior Krissy Mahon. She was successful on 70 of 77 hits at the net and floored 11 kills. Junior Kim Washnock was 22 of 26 hitting

with 5 kills and 7 blocks. Senior Andrea Salyer, a basketball standout playing volleyball for the first time, contributed 10 blocks at the net. Sophomore Amanda Porter and senior Natalie Koczura handled the setting duties for the Falcons.
