

Adat Shalom gala dinner caps jubilee

Adat Shalom Synagogue will cap its 50th anniversary celebration year with a Gala Jubilee Dinner on Wednesday, June 7.

The evening will feature a musical performance by Broadway actress and singer Tovah Feldshuh and the presentation of a commemorative video, "Adat Shalom ... The First Fifty Years."

Feldshuh created more than 20 roles in the first two seasons after her graduation from Sarah Lawrence College and training at the Tyrone Guthrie Theatre. She debuted on Broadway in the musical "Cyranos" and within 18 months of her arrival in New York starred in the play "Ventil" for which she won a Tony nomination.

Since then she has created a host of musical and dramatic roles, including nine Jews from birth to death in Allan Sherman's "Hello Muddah! Hello Padduh!"

Feldshuh made her cabaret debut in "Tovah Cross-Ovah: From Broadway to Cabaret," touring the United States and playing to sold-out houses in Israel. She also played an Emmy-nominated role as the Czech freedom fighter Helena in the NBC miniseries "Holocaust" and has appeared in "The Mia Farrow Story" and "As The World Turns."

Feldshuh received the Eleanor Roosevelt Humanitas Award and has been named woman of the year by Hadassah and mother of the year by Amit Women.

She will be accompanied at Adat Shalom by Robert Bendorff at the piano.

A tour of historic Jewish Detroit, a special memorial service at Adat Shalom Memorial Park, a June 2 Shabbat Evening Service honoring founding members and past presidents and a Shabbat Morning Service honoring past and present youth leadership are some of the jubilee events this spring.

Beverly Liss, Paul Magy and Ralph Woronoff have chaired the 50th anniversary celebrations. Liss is chairman of the gala dinner.

A Jubilee Commemorative Journal will be given to guests at the dinner. The journal project has been chaired by Magy, with Judy and Jeffrey Leder serving as journal editors.

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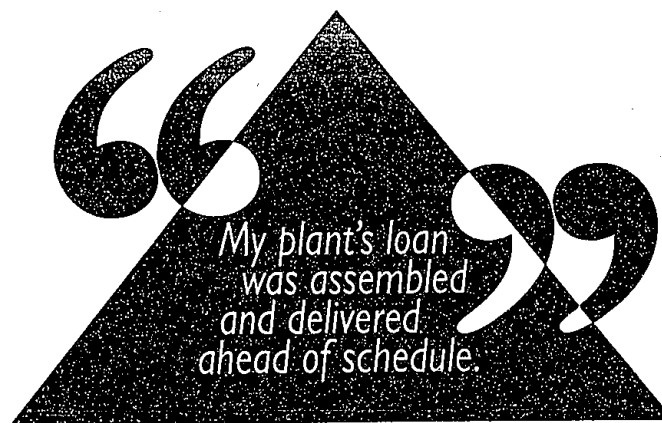
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
