Gas leak closes Power Road Friday

Farmington Hills firefighters closed off a section of Power Road between Alameda and 11 Mile Friday afternoon as a precaution after a gas leak.

Lt. Thomas Shurtleff said a contractor was boring for a water line under Hull when the Consumers Power gas line was accidentally struck at the northeast corner of Power and Hull.

"We're monitoring it to make sure that there is not too much

gas-to-air," he said. "With this wind, I don't think we'll have too much of a problem."

Shurtleff said cutting off the gas, which could be smelled a block away, was made difficult because it was a main that led in

two directions.

Police and firefighters were on the scene and residents in the immediate area were asked to leave their houses until the leak was controlled. Power Road was reopened at 5 p.m.

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
