The driver told Farmington Hills police by telephone that after dropping off the women at about 1045 p.m. Friday at the cafe, he had gone home to change and come back.

But when he returned at 2:30 a.m., he realized he had missed the party, and instead drove the limo to a Pitza Hut in Detroit, parked it and walked home.

Hills police have not been able to contact the driver since. Efforts by the Observer to reach the owner of the limousine company were unauccessful.

Detroit police recovered the limo Saturday evening. It had been broken into and everything
