Said Farmington Road resident George Taggart who would be affected by the restriction: "I don't know. There'll be some protest for sure."

Council members — especially Dick Tupper — have been concerned about right-of-way parking for a number of years. A recent Lawrence Technological University study on the Grand River corridor prompted thought about Farmington Road.

LTU students suggested pedestrian lighting, trees and shrubs for Grand River to bring together disparate commercial and residential elements. That same attention is needed for Farmington Road, city officials said.

For people exiting on Eight Mile and I-275 or traveling north from Livonia, that stretch of road is their first glimpse of both communities. There is a mix of commercial and residential property.

On the Hills side, smaller homes sit back from the road. No sidewalk exists, though one is

planned in the year 2000. And, some residents there park vehicles in their front yards.

Trees on both sides of the road might be one solution, said Lincoln Avery, chairman of Hills

Beautification Commission. "It's an area that we want to work together on," Avery said. "It might take some time to get it off the ground. We have some specific ideas.

"I think we can enhance it."
