Families in Action, League of Women Voters-Oakland Area and Farmington Area Republican Club, to only mention a few.

She backs up her membership with work, whether it's balancing a tray of food as a celebrity server at Big Boy for FFIA or taping name cards before a candidate's night.

"In my mind a volunteer never expects to be recognized," said Webb, who found out Friday she had been selected. "To be formally recognized is humbling.

"There's a ton of citizens of the year in this community. It's a privilege to work on everything I've been involved in."

Volunteering has come naturally.

Webb was asked to serve on the Gill Elementary PTA board before her sons, Jim and Matt, started kindergarten. She subse-

quently became school PTA president in 1989.

She's taken on other school and children-related tasks, handling the Farmington Youth Assistance recognition program from 1991-93 and helping found Advocates for Excellence in Education in 1992.

She was elected to the Farmington School Board in 1990.

"I have a very understanding family," said Webb, who is married to Jim and has two teen-age sons. "I try to reach a nice balance so I don't shortchange my family."

Her parents, Ed and Joyce Cleary, presented with her flowers upon hearing the news. Both will attend the Nov. 9 awards ceremony along with her husband and two children.

Webb said she was aware of the chamber's award, but never considered herself in contention. As for the zeal in which she tackles

her volunteer work, Webb is typically self-effacing.

"It's a privilege . . . It's not work," she said. "There's a lot of worthwhile things in the community to get involved in.

"I think you get energized by the people you work with."

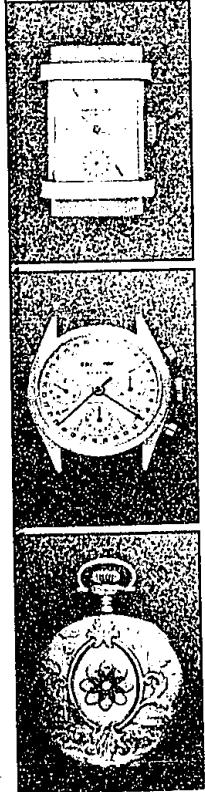
