A concrote stoop leads to the recessed frontentry, featuring a vaulted ceiling and handy quest closet. The sleeping areas are concentrated on the left side of the house.

open to each other, creating a nice uncrowded space to accommodate your visitors.


A built-in entertainment center will provide you with hours of enjoyment. The dining room contains lighted cabinots that are also accessible from the walk-through kitchen.
