## Health-O-Rama coming

**T**he Farmington Area Commission on Aging again will sponsor a site for Project Health-O-Rama from 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Wednesday, March 20, at the William M. Costick Activities Center on 11 Mile Road east of Middlebelt.

The basic health screening tests of blood pressure, height and weight, vision, hearing, podiatry and the Prostate Specific Antigen test for men will be offered.

There will be a new serum thyroid-stimulating hormone test, which is included in the blood panel

test. Also new this year is a CA125, which screens for ovarian cancer and other female reproductive disorders.

Health information and health promotion activities will be on-going during the testing operations.

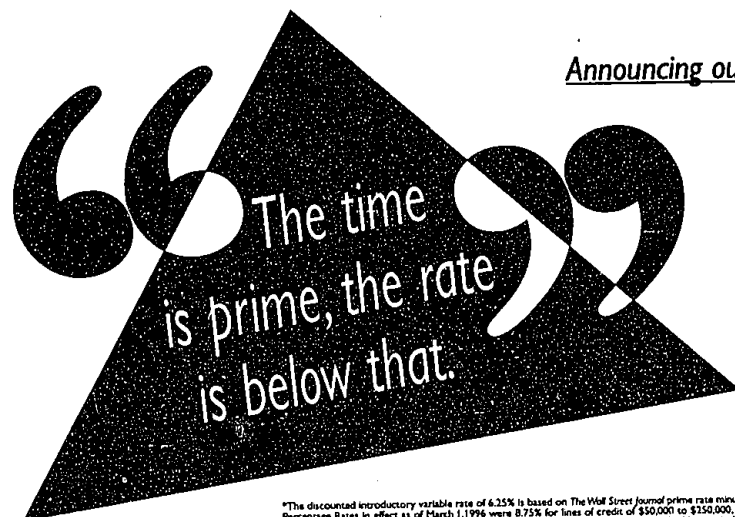
## Mom's Second Hand Sale

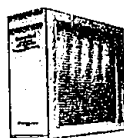

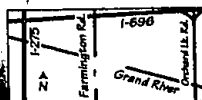
