Oakland University in Rochester Hills has launched a new marketing approach that combines marketing research with traditional student recruitment and retention efforts.

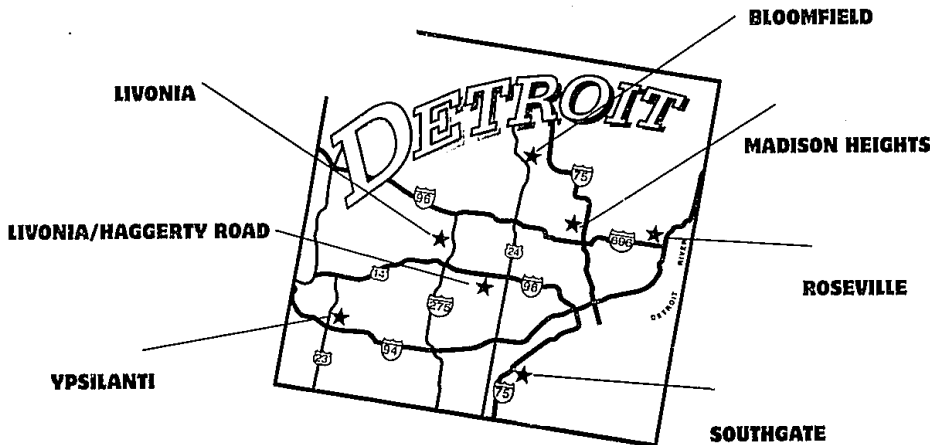
The Division of Continuing Education at Oakland University in Rochester Hills is now accepting
