a young city with growing pains. We worked hard, suffered abuse and harassment but we kept on and won.

Fortunately I still have the campaign literature from that time and would like to quote directly a few significant statements made by Mr. Moelke, "Taxes...are much too high...due to poor city planning will go higher unless the unfair reassessment is corrected...taxes forced people to sell their homes."

Taxes never came down, did they? Instead they've been climbing steadily and people are still leaving Livonia because of self-same taxes.

Harv, are you aware that Mary Stempin is fighting for the same things now that you fought for then? While he was in office he obtained, for the year 1965, a net increase of \$1,176,392 in state financial aid to education for the Livonia schools.

In 1966 the net increase rose to \$1,209,178. On the other hand Louis Schmidt, who you are forcing upon your appointees obtained a net increase of only \$264,158 and actually lost \$174,427 in aid to special education.

In 1968 he was able to recov-

er \$35,000 to Special Education for the year 1968. He received \$386,211—a far cry from Mr. Stempin's increases of over a million dollars for each year he was in office.

To quote your 1963 campaign literature again, "Citizens' rights have been abused by this administration."

What greater right does our democratic form of government offer than the right of freedom to choose your own candidate, to work for him and VOTE for him.

That's how you got into office. By what act of God or right of man do you presume to issue such an order to threaten to deprive a man of his living if he works for someone you apparently do not want in office.

You also pledged six years ago "I will constantly keep in mind the people's rights and be on guard to protect them and to warn the people of any situation that may put these rights in jeopardy."

Our country is bi-partisan, and for this I thank God, in our household we are independent voters. We vote for the man and not the party, in other words a split ticket.

Too many unqualified or ineffective men have ridden into office upon the coat tails of a strong party leader and candidate as Louis Schmidt rode in with Gov. Romney in 1966. I grant you it takes a little bit of time and thinking to study the men who are running for office, but to our community it's well worth the effort.

Harv, you were not able to fulfill all your promises. Our taxes are going higher. It is true that almost 70 per cent go for education and that is exactly why Mr. Stempin is so concerned about obtaining increased state aid for our schools and homestead tax exemption for all.

At the last school millage election the people clearly indicated that they had reached the limit of school taxation. Our city is still growing and the money for the schools must come from somewhere.

Mr. Stempin wants the state to put her shoulder to the wheel and relieve the burden of the overtaxed property owner. Let's return him to office to continue the good work that he did when he was there. He obtained increased state aid for our schools only to have Louis Schmidt lose it during his tenure.

Incidentally, if you care to check my resource material I have turned it over to Mr. Stempin. Why not pay him a visit and hand about The Stempin Program for a Better Livonia and Northville.

All I say, Harv, is that you check the records of the two men who held the same office and then see if you can then say with your past integrity, that Louis Schmidt is the better candidate.

That is, the bus it takes to transport the children back and forth and the tutors and drivers it takes to move them.

To sum up my pipe of steam, I say, the voters and only the voters, have the right to say how their monies should be spent and I'm sincerely against spending it in this manner.
