# Photos picture innovation


### PERSPECTIVES



Current exhibits at the Paint Creek Center for the Arts illustrate that photography knows no boundaries.

"Photo Transitions" is a show of photography featuring 10 area photographers. "Watershed Investigations" is a display by Mark Abrahamson. Both continue through June 28 at 407 Pine, Rochester (call (810) 651-4110).

For "Photo Transitions," curator Dawnice Korchhaert, PCCA director of exhibitions, selected five established artists who teach photography at Center for Creative Studies, the Cranbrook Academy of Art, Lawrence Technological University and Oakland Community College in Royal Oak. These five — Steven Benson, Andrea Eis, Robert Kahn, Steven Rost and Carl Toth — each invited a promising photographer. A strawberry field features dancing red spots. Construction work takes on an uneasy beauty. The roofs of long red buildings suggest the stripes on the flag. Markings on the earth suggest calligraphy. The land — part cultivated, part under cultivation — takes on different textures like cloths in a quilt.

Art on the Move is a program in which Center for Creative Studies sculpture students place large scale works in public. Detroit high school students help with construction of the projects. Artists will be on site during noon hours Fridays and Saturdays. Lavalla's sculpture, "Time Totems," is derived from a lay word record keeping system in the Earth's crust that reveals its experiences. Much like the Earth's strata, the totems reflect

the history of the city on many levels.
