POLICE AND FIRE CALLS

Listed below are some of the Farmington-area police incidents, fire calls and court cases reported during the past week.

CHASSED WITH BATS

In Farmington Hills:

Three teenaged boys were chased into a home in Farmington Hills by a group of bat-wielding teens early Friday evening. No one was injured but a window was broken in the fray.

The incident on Springbrook road began when a resident and two friends observed a group of teens acting suspicious outside the home. The boys told police they went outside to confront the group, who ran to a Ford Tempo and pulled out baseball bats. They chased the teens back into the home and one of the youths broke the front window, valued at \$300, before fleeing.

HARASSING CALLS

In Farmington Hills:

The co-owner of the Big Boy restaurant on Orchard Lake Road reported to police a plethora of harassing phone calls made to employees last Friday. The man would swear at employees and accuse the owners of treating workers badly. At least four

calls were made in an hour and a half period. The caller is believed to be the boyfriend of a former restaurant employee living in a Redford motel.

STEREO STOLEN

In Farmington Hills:

A teenager returning home after a week away camping in Grayling discovered his car, parked in the driveway on Whitlock during his absence, had been broken into and stereo equipment valued at over \$600 was taken.

The 17-year-old told police the driver's side window on the 1979 Chevrolet Malibu had been pulled from the door. A screwdriver was left on the car seat. Police lifted prints from the door panel and screwdriver.

MOM ASSAULTED

In Farmington Hills:

An argument between a 45-year-old Farmington Hills woman and her 16-year-old daughter escalated to violence on Friday.

According to police, the mother came home from Oakland Community College in the early afternoon and started arguing

with her daughter. The teen says her mother slapped her several times on the head. She retaliated by hitting her mother in the head with a Snapple iced tea bottle, causing a cut to the forehead. Emergency medical technicians responded and the woman was transported to Botaford Hospital for treatment. The teen was taken into custody and two younger children were brought in to the juvenile department. The father was notified.

HOME INVADIED

In Farmington Hills:

A late night card party was interrupted by two armed men who robbed the teenaged participants and left them in a bathroom before fleeing with cash and jewelry.

The 18-year-old resident of Raleigh street told police that there was a knock at the door at 11:40 p.m. A teen asked for Shaun. Shaun went to the door and the two entered. One then put on a ski mask and announced the holdup, brandishing a gun. The six teens from Farmington Hills and Novi were ordered against a wall where

they were frisked and robbed of more than \$100 total. The teen resident of the home was then ordered to escort the duo upstairs, where they ransacked his father's bedroom and left with a gold watch valued at \$200 and a \$100 bracelet. He was then put in the bathroom with the other houseguests and the two intruders fled.

The two are described as black males, in their late teens, one tall and one short and heavy. Shaun told police that he knew the one intruder as a cousin of two brothers he knew in Detroit. The man was recently released from jail.

JEEP STOLEN

In Farmington Hills:

A 1995 Jeep Grand Cherokee brought into Bob Saks Dodge for service on Friday was stolen.

Workers told police they last saw the green jeep, belonging to a Rochester Hills man, at 6 p.m. When a worker went outside the garage to pull it in, the jeep was missing. There was no sign of forced entry, such as broken glass. The service department still had the keys.

Trial date set for Cayce in rape case

An August 5 trial date has been set for Arthur Hollingsworth Cayce, the 24-year-old Farmington Hills man charged with abducting and raping his 22-year-old ex-girlfriend.

According to earlier reports, Cayce and the alleged victim had dated for 4 1/2 years, before breaking up in the spring of 1995.

The alleged victim, also of Farmington Hills, told the court that Cayce approached her in the parking lot as she left the YMCA on Dec. 27, 1995. He grabbed her from behind, told her he had a gun and dragged her to his car, she testified.

He allegedly handcuffed her and drove to a Detroit hotel, where he is said to have raped and beat her.

Cayce will stand trial before Oakland County Circuit Court Judge Rudy Nichols on kidnapping, criminal sexual conduct in the first degree and extortion charges. Bond was denied.

Cayce is also facing murder and arson charges in connection with an arson death that claimed the lives of Melissa Bovair, 21, and her mother Louise, 52.
